We have three defibrillators in the village at present and an additional defibrillator and bleed kit which is on order, this will be installed on the outer wall of the Old Fire Station. The Parish Council has funded two additional pieces of equipment which are currently being installed at Plumberow Playground.



The Parish Council has also installed an interactive screen which is an asset to community groups and Council Meetings.

In September we recruited a new Parish Clerk / RFO Karen Hawkes and a new administrative assistant. Both are full time members of staff and we wish them well at Hockley Parish Council.

We will continue to strive to improve the Hockley facility whilst still maintaining our village atmosphere.
